Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Goodman-Armstrong Creek School District, in cooperation with the County and State Board of Health and the County and State Dental Society, is offering to all students a fluoride mouth-rinsing program to prevent dental decay. This simple method of applying fluoride has been demonstrated to be safe and effective in controlling tooth decay. Participants will rinse their mouths with a 0.2% neutral sodium fluoride solution for one minute, once each week, under supervision. The solution is not swallowed.

This project is very important to the oral health of your child. Participation is entirely voluntary and without cost to you or the school district. We encourage you to allow your child to participate in this valuable health project. This preventive program, however, should not take the place of regular dental care by your dentist or proper home care.
